**Lough Derg**, historically **Lough Dergart** (<u>Irish</u>: *Loch Deirgeirt*), is a freshwater lake in the <u>Shannon River Basin</u>, Ireland. It is the third-biggest on the island of Ireland (after <u>Lough Neagh</u> and <u>Lough Corrib</u>).

It is a long, narrow lake, with shores in counties <u>Clare</u> (south-west), <u>Galway</u> (north-west), and <u>Tipperary</u> (to the east). It is the southernmost of three large lakes on the <u>River Shannon</u>; the others being <u>Lough Ree</u> and <u>Lough Allen</u>. Towns and villages on Lough Derg include Portumna, Killaloe & Ballina, Dromineer, Terryglass, Mountshannon and Garrykennedy.

### **Dromineer Village**

A small village in North Tipperary, Ireland. It is situated on the shores of Lough Derg on the River Shannon. The village is located 10 kilometres northwest of Nenagh. It is a civil parish in the historical barony of Ormond Lower. Home to an 11th century tower house, idyllic scenery, a public harbour, and other facilities, it is a popular place to visit, especially for those out boating on the lake. The name Dromineer in Irish is "Drom Inbhir", meaning the back or the ford of the river. The Nenagh River flows out into Lough Derg at Dromineer.

Amenities in Dromineer include a public marina and harbour, one restaurant and pub (The Whiskey Still), some holiday accommodation (Holiday Homes and Hostel Accommodation)

Dromineer is home to the Lough Derg Lifeboat, which is the RNLI 's third inland lifeboat station and the first in Ireland.

The data suggests that 69% of days will have wind in excess or 10knots at launch time with a gradually decreasing breeze towards evening.

Likelyhood of extreme wind events are close to zero with only 6% probability of winds in excess of 20knots.

The predonimant wind direction is SW followed by W.
