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NOTICE OF RACE Short Course Event Lake Albert Meningie

28th Feb and 1st March 2015

RULES

The organising authority of the regatta is **the International Fireball Association of South Australia**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. The class rules of the **International Fireball** shall apply.

ADVERTISING

Advertising will be as defined by ISAF regulation 20.

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. The organising authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the South Australian or Australian Governments.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the International Fireball class.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to the Treasurer.

Late entries will be accepted up to 13:00 hrs. on 28th Feb 2015.

FEES

Required fees are in \$AUS:

Entry fee; low rate \$30, before the 26th Feb. 2015.

Late Entry fee applies to entries received after 26th Feb 2015, Entry fee of \$40 is applicable. Non-IFASA Members; low rate of \$40. Entries received after 27th Feb 2015, late fee of \$50 applies.

Fees include, BBQ tea Sat Night and Breakfast on Sunday morning, for both Skipper and Crew.

Numerus races are scheduled.

No warning signal shall be made after 15:00 hours on Sunday the 1st March.

No more than Six races will be sailed back to back.

MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall hold a valid certificate.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 11:00 on 28th Feb 2015 at race area

VENUE

The Lake Albert Caravan Park, Meningie.

Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta and the approximate location of the racing areas.

THE COURSES

The course to be sailed will be Windward /4 Reaching angles / Windward finish.

Course diagrams, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left will be provided in the sailing Instructions. Target time 30 minutes.

SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than **Four** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When **Four** to **Six** races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When **Eight** or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

SAFETY

All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices that are in good condition and are in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation and branded in the country of origin or manufacture.

Attention is drawn to Rule 1.2 and Rule 4

Attention is draw to the fact that Rescue boats will be limited and that self rescue must be upper most in competitors minds, if assistance is required, the raising of an arm or arms waving from side to side for assistance or any method to gain attention, from Start / Finish Boat, when there is a race in progress and assistance is a matter of safety, there will be an abandoned to the race, to render, urgent assistance.

RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the organising authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, a boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio transmissions except for equipment provided by the organising authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the IFASA at the annual presentation of awards.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5M Aus (\$10M recommended) or the equivalent. All owners/competitors who sign the Entry Form are deemed to have made a declarationthat they hold such cover.

AMENDMENTS

Any amendment to this Notice of Race will be emailed out to members.
